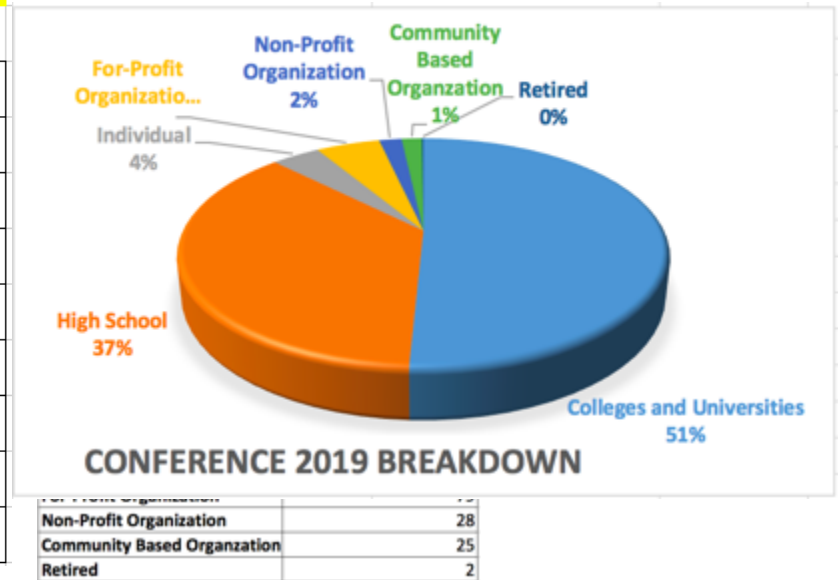


# 2019 International ACAC Conference Attendance – Who is Here?
